ARCHERY

The archery field is one of our few unscheduled activities so campers can explore the area when they please. It will be open to shoot 10am-noon, 1pm-4pm each day

ARTISTS' VILLAGE

PACKAGE REQUIRED

CLIMBING WALL

Reach new heights and see camp from a new perspective. Another activity you can do when you prefer, the climbing wall will be open 10-noon, 1pm-4pm. An instructor must be present to participate



COSTUME CONTEST

Show off your favorite cosplay or costume and strut your stuff during the Great Feast. The Whimsy Forge team will decide who is the best in the hollow, so get creative

PACKAGE REQUIRED
